





# DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Armed Conflict Incident in Brgy. Magsaysay, Mapanas, Northern Samar

as of 22 March 2024, 6PM

## I. Situation Overview

On 19 March 2024, an armed conflict between the government troops of the Philippine Army and the Communist Terrorists Groups transpired in the boundaries of Brgy. Osmeña, Palagpag, Northern Samar and Brgy. Magsaysay. Mapanas, Northern Samar, affecting families and individuals in the community whose livelihood depends on farming.

In response to the incident, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region VIII, actively engaged in the response operation and continuously coordinating with the concerned LGU for significant updates and possible requests for relief augmentation.
