

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Armed Conflict in Del Gallego, Camarines Sur as of 11 March 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 04 January 2024 at around 4:22 AM, an armed conflict transpired between the troops of 9th Infantry Division of the Philippine Army (PA) and alleged members of the Communist Party of the Philippines - New People's Army (CPP-NPA) in the Municipality of Del Gallego, Camarines Sur, which resulted in the displacement of families and individuals.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **145 families** or **725 persons** are affected in **two (2) barangays** in **Del Gallego, Camarines Sur** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are **19 families** or **88 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives (see Annex B).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱68,851.20** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex C).
