





DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Armed Conflict in Del Gallego, Camarines Sur

as of 11 March 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 04 January 2024 at around 4:22 AM, an armed conflict transpired between the troops of 9th Infantry Division of the Philippine Army (PA) and alleged members of the Communist Party of the Philippines - New People's Army (CPP-NPA) in the Municipality of Del Gallego, Camarines Sur, which resulted in the displacement of families and individuals.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 145 families or 725 persons are affected in two (2) barangays in Del Gallego, Camarines Sur (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are 19 families or 88 persons temporarily staying with their relatives (see Annex B).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P68,851.20** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex C).
