





# DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Effects of Easterlies in North Cotabato

as of 30 March 2024, 6AM

#### I. Situation Overview

On 28 March 2024, the effects of Easterlies were reported in the municipalities of Kabacan, Libungan, and Pigcawayan in North Cotabato Province. The Easterlies brought a significant amount of rain associated with strong winds which resulted to the displacement of families and persons.

Relative to the incident, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region XII, are actively engaged in the response operation, and continuously coordinating with the concerned LGU for significant updates and possible requests for relief augmentation.

# II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 168 families or 722 persons are affected in 17 barangays in North Cotabato Province (see Annex A).

# III. Status of Displaced Population

#### **Outside Evacuation Center**

There are **34 families** or **169 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

# IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 153 houses were damaged; of which, 33 are totally damaged and 120 are partially damaged in North Cotabato Province (see Annex C).
