

## DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Alabang, Muntinlupa City as of 20 March 2024, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 17 March 2024 at around 4:48 AM, a fire incident transpired in Brgy. Alabang, Muntinlupa City and was declared fire out at around 9:42 AM. This incident has led to displacement of families and individuals in the community.

Relative to the incident, the DSWD through its Field Office in the National Capital Region, actively engaged in the response operation, and continuously coordinating with the concerned LGU for significant updates and possible requests for relief augmentation.
