



# DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Balulang, Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental

as of 25 March 2024, 6PM

# I. Situation Overview

On 29 February 2024 at around 1:31 PM, a fire incident occurred at Sitio Manggahan, Brgy. Balulang, Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental. The fire was declared out at around 3:50 PM.

# II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **20 families** or **71 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Balulang, Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental** (see Annex A).

# III. Status of Displaced Population

#### **Inside Evacuation Center**

A total of **20 families** or **71 persons** sought temporary shelter at the **Covered Court** in **Brgy. Balulang, Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental** (see Annex B). These families have already returned home and are gradually reconstructing their houses.

# IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **14 houses** were damaged; of which, **11** are **totally damaged** and **three (3)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Balulang, Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental** (see Annex D).

# V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱200,995.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱158,330.00** from **DSWD** and **₱42,665.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex E).
