





DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Cansojong, Talisay City, Cebu

as of 22 March 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 19 March 2024 at around 11:14 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Cansojong, Talisay City, Cebu which escalated to fourth alarm before being completely extinguished at around 12:30 PM.

The incident has led to displacement of families and individuals in the community. Hence, Camp Coordination and Camp Management (CCCM) teams were activated to monitor and secure the living conditions of IDPs and ensure equal access to humanitarian services.

In response, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region VII together with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Talisay City, provided relief assistance comprising Food and Non-Food Items (NFIs) to support the immediate needs of affected families and individuals.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **128 families** or **546 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Cansojong**, **Talisay City**, **Cebu** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are 126 families or 488 persons currently taking temporary shelter in two (2) evacuation centers in Brgy. Cansojong, Talisay City, Cebu (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 128 houses were damaged; of which, 125 are totally damaged and three (3) are partially damaged in Brgy. Cansojong, Talisay City, Cebu (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}1,801,852.00\$ worth of assistance was provided to the affected families composed of \$\mathbb{P}221,852.00\$ from \$\mathbb{D}SWD\$ and \$\mathbb{P}1,580,000.00\$ from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex F).
