





# DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Cansomoroy, Balamban, Cebu

as of 18 May 2024, 6AM

### I. Situation Overview

On 25 March 2024 at around 11:28 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Cansomoroy, Balamban, Cebu. The fire was declared out at around 12:10 PM.

One (1) family or five (5) persons are affected in Brgy. Cansomoroy, Balamban, Cebu (see Annex A).

## III. Status of Displaced Population

One (1) family or five (5) persons temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

# IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was totally damaged in Brgy. Cansomoroy, Balamban, Cebu (see Annex C).

#### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱19,882.50 worth of assistance was provided to the affected family; of which, ₱6,482.50 from DSWD, ₱3,400.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) and ₱10,000.00 from other Partners (see Annex D).
