
DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Dadiangas West, General Santos City, South Cotabato as of 04 March 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 29 February 2024 at around 8 AM, a fire incident occurred at Purok San Juan, Brgy. Dadiangas West, General Santos City, South Cotabato.

Relative to the incident, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region XII, provided relief augmentation to support the immediate needs of the affected families and individuals.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **80 families** or **271 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Dadiangas West, General Santos City, South Cotabato** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **80 families** or **271 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Purok San Juan Covered Court** in **Brgy. Dadiangas West, General Santos City, South Cotabato** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **44 houses** were damaged; of which, **39** are **totally damaged** and **five (5)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Dadiangas West, General Santos City, South Cotabato** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱748,580.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex F).
