





# DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Damayang Lagi, Quezon City

as of 21 March 2024, 6AM

#### I. Situation Overview

On 19 March 2024 at around 10:34 AM, a fire incident occurred at Isla Noah, Brgy. Damayang Lagi, Quezon City, and was declared fire out at around 12:30 PM. The incident led to displacement of families and individuals in the community.

In response, the DSWD through its Field Office in the National Capital Region (NCR), provided relief assistance to support the immediate needs of the affected families.

A total of **206 families** or **741 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Damayang Lagi**, **Quezon City** (see Annex A).

# III. Status of Displaced Population

#### **Inside Evacuation Center**

There are **206 families** or **741 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **two (2) evacuation centers** in **Quezon City** (see Annex B).

# IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 105 houses were totally damaged in Brgy. Damayang Lagi, Quezon City (see Annex C).

#### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P137,997.34** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
