





DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Looc, Mandaue City, Cebu

as of 15 March 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 12 March 2024 at around 12:06 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Looc, Mandaue City, Cebu. The Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP) immediately responded to the area. The fire was declared out at around 2:16 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **516 families** or **1,745 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Looc, Mandaue City, Cebu** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are 516 families or 1,745 persons currently taking temporary shelter at the Cesar M. Cabahug Elementary School in Brgy. Looc, Mandaue City, Cebu (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **393 houses** were damaged; of which, **386** are **totally damaged** and **seven (7)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Looc, Mandaue City, Cebu** (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱3,926,682.90 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, ₱326,682.90 from DSWD and ₱3,600,000.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex F).
