
DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Old Airport, Mandurriao, Iloilo City

as of 06 March 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 05 March 2024 at around 7:49 AM, a fire incident occurred at Zone 1, Brgy. Old Airport, Mandurriao, Iloilo City, and was declared fire out at around 9:01 AM. Initial reports indicated that 45 residential houses were damaged resulting in the displacement of families and individuals.

Relative to the incident, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region VI, provided immediate relief assistance to meet the needs of the affected families and individuals. Additional support is anticipated following the completion of validation and upon request of the concerned Local Government Unit (LGU).

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **84 families** or **292 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Old Airport, Mandurriao, Iloilo City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **84 families** or **292 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at **Mandurriao Elementary School** in **Brgy. Old Airport, Mandurriao, Iloilo City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **59 houses** were damaged; of which, **55** are **totally damaged** and **four (4)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Old Airport, Mandurriao, Iloilo City** (see Annex D).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱649,737.63** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex B).
