I. Situation Overview

On 13 March 2024 at around 11:51 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Poblacion, Mandaluyong City. The fire was declared out the next day at around 1:11 AM.

A total of **59 families** or **247 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Poblacion, Mandaluyong City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **59 families** or **247 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Brgy. Poblacion Community Center** in **Mandaluyong City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **22 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Poblacion, Mandaluyong** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱280,193.40** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex C).
