
DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Poblacion, Titay, Zamboanga Sibugay

as of 04 April 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 28 March 2024 at around 3:32 AM, a fire incident occurred at Purok Peña Rosa, Brgy. Poblacion, Titay, Zamboanga Sibugay. The Municipal Fire Station of the LGU of Titay, Zamboanga Sibugay immediately responded to put out the fire.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **35 families** or **45 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Poblacion, Titay, Zamboanga Sibugay** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **two (2) families** or **two (2) persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Titay Isolation Center** in **Brgy. Poblacion, Titay, Zamboanga Sibugay** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **33 families** or **43 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are **35 families** or **45 persons** displaced in **Brgy. Poblacion, Titay, Zamboanga Sibugay** (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **12 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Poblacion, Titay, Zamboanga Sibugay** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱17,027.50** worth of assistance from **DSWD** was provided to the affected families (see Annex D).
