





DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. San Juan, Surigao City, Surigao del Norte

as of 18 March 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 12 March 2024 at around 3:50 PM, a fire incident occurred at Purok 3, Saint Arnold, Brgy. San Juan, Surigao City, Surigao del Norte. The fire was declared out at around 5:45 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **44 families** or **191 persons** are affected in **Brgy. San Juan, Surigao City, Surigao del Norte** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are 44 families or 191 persons currently taking temporary shelter at Surigao City National High School in Brgy. San Juan, Surigao City, Surigao del Norte (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 39 houses were damaged; of which, 37 are totally damaged and two (2) are partially damaged in Brgy. San Juan, Surigao City, Surigao del Norte (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱589,764.71 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, ₱442,684.71 from DSWD and ₱147,080.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex D).

1. Standby Funds

- ₱26.36 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) available at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱5 million available at DSWD FO Caraga.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 86,011 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 81,542 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 4,469 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 67,474 FFPs available at DSWD FO Caraga.
- ₱457.96 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO Caraga warehouses.

b. Food and Non-food Items (FNIs)
