I. Situation Overview

On 27 February 2024 at around 11:15 AM, a fire incident occurred at Cadiz St., Brgy. Tatalon, Quezon City. The fire was declared out at around 12PM.

Inside Evacuation Center

There are 136 families or 479 persons currently taking temporary shelter at Diosdado Macapagal Elementary School in Brgy. Tatalon, Quezon City (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **55 houses** were totally damaged in **Brgy. Tatalon**, **Quezon City** (see Annex C).
