
DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Flooding Incidents in Davao Occidental

as of 06 March 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

Issued on 29 February 2024 at around 04:00 PM, cloudy skies with scattered rain showers and thunderstorms caused by Easterlies may have brought possible flash floods or landslides due to moderate to at times heavy rains in Caraga and Davao Region.

On the same day, several barangays in the municipalities of Malita and Sta. Maria in Davao Occidental experienced flooding due to Easterlies that resulted in the displacement of families and individuals.

Relative to the incident, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region XI, actively engaged in the monitoring of response operation, and continuously coordinating with the concerned LGU for any significant updates and possible requests for relief augmentation.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **3,485 families** or **11,719 persons** are affected in **23 barangays** in **Davao Occidental** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **513 families** or **1,711 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **three (3) evacuation centers** in **Davao Occidental** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **nine (9) families** or **28 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are **522 families** or **1,739 persons** displaced in **Davao Occidental** (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **18 houses** were damaged; of which, **17 are totally damaged** and **one (1) is partially damaged** in **Davao Occidental** (see Annex C).
