



DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Soil Erosion Incident in Hamtic, Antique

as of 17 March 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 01 March 2024, soil cracks and massive soil erosion were reported in several barangays in the municipality of Hamtic, Antique. The result of the investigation led by the Municipal Disaster Risk Response Management Office (MDRRMO) of Hamtic and Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH) resulted in the displacement of families and individuals residing in the affected areas.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **31 families** or **130 persons** are affected in **three (3) barangays** in **Hamtic**, **Antique** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are **31 families** or **130 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **31 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Hamtic**, **Antique** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱214,458.00** worth of assistance was provided by the **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
