



DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Armed Conflict in Del Gallego, Camarines Sur

as of 12 March 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 04 January 2024 at around 4:22 AM, an armed conflict transpired between the troops of 9th Infantry Division of the Philippine Army (PA) and alleged members of the Communist Party of the Philippines – New People's Army (CPP-NPA) in the Municipality of Del Gallego, Camarines Sur, which resulted in the displacement of families and individuals.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **145 families** or **725 persons** are affected in **two (2) barangays** in **Del Gallego, Camarines Sur** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are **19 families** or **88 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives (see Annex B).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱348,086.30** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex C).

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 93,314 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 86,945 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 6,369 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 110,288 available at DSWD FO V.
- ₱594.14 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO V warehouses.

b. Food and Non-food Items (FNIs)

12 March 2024	 DSWD FO V led by Regional Director Norman Laurio and the Municipal Social Welfare and Development Office (MSWDO) of the LGU of Del Gallego, Camarines Sur distribute additional FNIs to displaced families and individuals, and affected farmers.
11 March 2024	 DSWD FO V facilitated the provision of FNIs such as FFPs, sleeping kits, and family kits intended for distribution to the affected families and individuals.
04 March 2024	 DSWD FO V through its Municipal Action Team (MAT) and the LGU of Del Gallego, Camarines Sur provided FNIs such as FFPs and hygiene kits to the affected families and individuals.
