# DSWD DROMIC Report \#3 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 105, Tondo, Manila City <br> as of 25 March 2024, 6PM 

## I. Situation Overview

On 21 March 2024 at around 10:34 PM, a fire incident occurred at Aroma St., Happyland, Brgy. 105, Tondo, Manila City. The fire was declared out the next day at around 5:28 AM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of $\mathbf{6 6 1}$ families or $\mathbf{2 , 4 1 3}$ persons are affected in Brgy. 105, Tondo, Manila City (see Annex A).

## III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are 465 families or 1,860 persons currently taking temporary shelter in three (3) evacuation centers in Brgy. 105, Tondo, Manila City (see Annex B).
b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are 196 families or 553 persons temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).
c. Total Displaced Population

There are 661 families or 2,413 persons displaced in Brgy. 105, Tondo, Manila City (see Annex D).

## IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 163 houses were totally damaged in Brgy. 105, Happyland, Tondo, Manila City (see Annex E).

## V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of $P 900,258.45$ worth of assistance was provided by DSWD to the affected families (see Annex F).
