





# DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 105, Tondo, Manila City

as of 25 March 2024, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 21 March 2024 at around 10:34 PM, a fire incident occurred at Aroma St., Happyland, Brgy. 105, Tondo, Manila City. The fire was declared out the next day at around 5:28 AM.

# II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **661 families** or **2,413 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 105, Tondo, Manila City** (see Annex A).

## III. Status of Displaced Population

#### a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are 465 families or 1,860 persons currently taking temporary shelter in three (3) evacuation centers in Brgy. 105, Tondo, Manila City (see Annex B).

#### b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **196 families** or **553 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

#### c. Total Displaced Population

There are **661 families** or **2,413 persons** displaced in **Brgy. 105, Tondo, Manila City** (see Annex D).

# IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 163 houses were totally damaged in Brgy. 105, Happyland, Tondo, Manila City (see Annex E).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}900,258.45\$ worth of assistance was provided by \$\mathbb{DSWD}\$ to the affected families (see Annex F).
