## **DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Addition Hills, Mandaluyong City**

as of 19 April 2024, 6PM

### **I. Situation Overview**

On March 21, 2024, a fire broke out at Block 32 Extension, Addition Hills, Mandaluyong City, starting around 8:47 AM and was declared fire out at around 10:09 AM. The incident has led to displacement of estimated 72 families, totaling 224 individuals, with five (5) reported casualties.

The DSWD through its Field Office in the National Capital Region, actively engaged in the response operation, and provided relief augmentation to support the immediate needs of the affected families and individuals.

### **II. Status of Affected Areas and Population**

A total of **61 families** or **235 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Addition Hills, Mandaluyong City** (see Annex A).

### **III. Status of Displaced Population**

#### **Inside Evacuation Center**

There are **61 families** or **235 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **two (2) evacuation centers** in **Brgy. Addition Hills, Mandaluyong City** (see Annex B).

### **IV. Damaged Houses**

A total of **25 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Addition Hills, Mandaluyong City** (see Annex D).

### **V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided**

A total of **₱495,408.96** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex E).
