





# DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Old Airport, Mandurriao, Iloilo City

## I. Situation Overview

On 05 March 2024 at around 7:49 AM, a fire incident occurred at Zone 1, Brgy. Old Airport, Mandurriao, Iloilo City. The fire was declared out at around 9:01 AM.

# II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **84 families** or **292 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Old Airport, Mandurriao, Iloilo City** (see Annex A).

# III. Status of Displaced Population

#### **Inside Evacuation Center**

There are **84 families** or **292 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at **Mandurriao Elementary School** in **Brgy. Old Airport, Mandurriao, Iloilo City** (see Annex B).

# IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **59 houses** were damaged; of which, **55** are **totally damaged** and **four (4)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Old Airport, Mandurriao, Iloilo City** (see Annex C).

## V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P814**,785.63 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **P600**,135.63 from **DSWD** and **P214**,650.00 from the **Local Government Unit** (**LGU**) (see Annex D).
