





DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Poblacion, Mandaluyong City

as of 20 March 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 13 March 2024 at around 11:40 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Poblacion, Mandaluyong City, and was declared fire out the next day at approximately 1:11 AM. The incident has led to displacement of families and individuals in the community with reported number of casualties.

Relative to the incident, the DSWD through its Field Office in the National Capital Region, actively engaged in the response operation and promptly provided relief assistance to support the immediate needs of the affected families and individuals.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **66 families** or **270 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Poblacion**, **Mandaluyong City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **66 families** or **270 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Brgy. Poblacion Community Center** in **Mandaluyong City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **22 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Poblacion, Mandaluyong** (see Annex D).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P412,978.14** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex E).
