



# DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. San Juan, Surigao City, Surigao del Norte

as of 20 March 2024, 6PM

# I. Situation Overview

On 12 March 2024 at around 3:50 PM, a fire incident occurred at Purok 3, Saint Arnold, Brgy. San Juan, Surigao City, Surigao del Norte. The fire was declared out at around 5:45 PM.

# II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **46 families** or **201 persons** are affected in **Brgy. San Juan, Surigao City, Surigao del Norte** (see Annex A).

# III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **45 families** or **192 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at **Surigao City National High School** in **Brgy. San Juan, Surigao City, Surigao del Norte** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center
 One (1) or nine (9) persons temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex E).

#### c. Total Displaced Population

There are **46 families** or **201 persons** displaced in **Brgy. San Juan, Surigao City, Surigao del Norte** (see Annex F).

# IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **40 houses** were damaged; of which, **37** are **totally damaged** and **three (3)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. San Juan, Surigao City, Surigao del Norte** (see Annex G).

# V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱669,220.94** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱552,140.94** from **DSWD** and **₱147,080.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex H).
