



DSWD DROMIC Report #4 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Alabang, Muntinlupa City

as of 25 March 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 17 March 2024 at around 4:48 AM, a fire incident transpired in Brgy. Alabang, Muntinlupa City and was declared fire out at around 9:42 AM. This incident has led to displacement of families and individuals in the said community.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **1,025 families** or **4,100 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Alabang, Muntinlupa City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **377 families** or **1,508 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **three (3) evacuation centers** in **Brgy. Alabang, Muntinlupa City** (see Annex B).

- **b.** Outside Evacuation Center There are 648 families or 2,592 persons temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).
- c. Total Displaced Population There are 1,025 families or 4,100 persons displaced in Brgy. Alabang, Muntinlupa City (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **321 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Alabang, Muntinlupa City** (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱2,738,622.20** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex G).

17 March 2024	 The LGU of Muntinlupa City through its Social Services Department (SSD) conducted intake interviews, assessment, validation, and master listing of families and individuals affected by the fire incident.

25 March 2024	 DSWD FO NCR maintains close coordination with the LGU of Muntinlupa City and other concerned agencies for significant updates and any further requests for relief augmentation.
17 March 2024	 DSWD FO NCR through its DRMD conducted Rapid Damage Assessment and Needs Analysis (RDANA). The LGU of Muntinlupa City through its SSD activated its respective response clusters.
