





DSWD DROMIC Report #4 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Cansojong, Talisay City, Cebu

as of 24 March 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 19 March 2024 at around 11:14 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Cansojong, Talisay City, Cebu. The fire was declared out at around 12:30 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **129 families** or **550 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Cansojong, Talisay City, Cebu** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are 129 families or 550 persons currently taking temporary shelter in two (2) evacuation centers in Brgy. Cansojong, Talisay City, Cebu (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 128 houses were damaged; of which, 125 are totally damaged and three (3) are partially damaged in Brgy. Cansojong, Talisay City, Cebu (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}3,935,792.95\$ worth of assistance was provided to the affected families composed of \$\mathbb{P}2,355,792.95\$ from \$\mathbb{D}SWD\$ and \$\mathbb{P}1,580,000.00\$ from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex F).
