

DSWD DROMIC Report #5 on the Armed Conflict in Northern Samar

as of 01 April 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 19 March 2024, an armed conflict transpired between the government troops of the Philippine Army and members of the Communist Party of the Philippines–New People's Army (CPP-NPA) in the boundaries of Brgy. Osmeña, Palapag, Northern Samar and Brgy. Magsaysay, Mapanas, Northern Samar. According to reports, the armed encounter had significant impact on the livelihood of the families and individuals in the affected areas.

A total of **1,007 families** or **3,496 persons** are affected in **three (3) barangays** in **Northern Samar** (see Annex A).
