





DSWD DROMIC Report #6 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Poblacion VII, Roxas City, Capiz

as of 08 March 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 27 February 2024 at around 2:00 PM, a fire incident occurred at Rizal Street in Brgy. Poblacion VII, Roxas City, Capiz. The fire was declared out at around 2:47 PM.

In response, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region VI, together with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Roxas City, provided relief assistance to support the immediate needs of the affected families.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **103 families** or **391 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Poblacion VII, Roxas City, Capiz** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **70 families** or **271 persons** sought temporary shelter at the **Rufina Andrada Santos Memorial School** in **Brgy. Poblacion VII, Roxas City, Capiz** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **30 families** or **105 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

A total of **100 families** or **376 persons** were displaced in **Brgy. Poblacion VII, Roxas City, Capiz** (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **87 houses** were damaged; of which, **83** are **totally damaged** and **four (4)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Poblacion VII, Roxas City, Capiz** (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}7,015,731.00\$ worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; composed of \$\mathbb{P}4,271,424.00\$ from the DSWD, \$\mathbb{P}1,035,000.00\$ from the Local Government Unit (LGU), and \$\mathbb{P}1,709,307.00\$ from Other Partners (see Annex F).

1. Standby Funds

- ₱34.48 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱5 million available at DSWD FO VI.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 108,314 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 100,345 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 7,969 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.

28 February 2024	 DSWD FO VI distributed FNIs to the families affected by the fire incident. The LGU of Roxas City through its Health Unit facilitated the provision of medicines and vitamins to the displaced families.

c. Other Activities

DATE	ACTIVITIES
04 March 2024	DSWD FO VI maintains close coordination with the LGU of Roxas for significant disaster response updates and for further relief augmentation requests.
29 February 2024	 DSWD FO VI spearheaded by Assistant Regional Director for Administration (ARDA) Joselito G. Estember visited the evacuation center to conduct monitoring and assessment of the IDPs. DSWD FO VI facilitated the provision of financial assistance through the Assistance to Individuals in Crisis Situation (AICS) to the families affected by the fire incident.
28 February 2024	 The LGU of Roxas City through its Health Unit conducted medical checkup to the displaced families and persons. DSWD FO VI spearheaded by Assistant Regional Director for Administration (ARDA) Joselito G. Estember visited the open evacuation center to conduct needs assessment of the IDPs and provided technical assistance to the LGU of Roxas City.
27 February 2024	DSWD FO VI led by the Social Welfare and Development (SWAD) Team Leader provided technical assistance to the
