





DSWD DROMIC Report #9 on the Armed Conflict in Lanao del Norte

as of 13 March 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 16 February 2024, an armed conflict transpired in Brgy. Pantao, Munai, Lanao del Norte between Dawlah Islamiyah – Maute Group (DI-MG) and the Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP) which resulted in the displacement of families and individuals in the area and the nearby Municipality of Tangcal, Lanao del Norte.

Another armed encounter occurred between the two (2) groups in Brgy. Lindongan and Brgy. Matampay in the Municipality of Munai, Lanao del Norte on 18 February 2024 and 21 February 2024, respectively.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **770 families** or **3,641 persons** are affected in **eight (8) barangays** in **Lanao del Norte** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **279 families** or **1,396 persons** sought temporary shelter in **two (2) evacuation centers** in **Tangcal**, **Lanao del Norte** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **38 families** or **165 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are **38 families** or **165 persons** displaced in **Lanao del Norte** (see Annex D).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱576,277.59 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, ₱362,959.59 from DSWD, and ₱213,318.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex E).

26 February 2024	 DSWD FO X through its Disaster Response and Rehabilitation Section processed the request for augmentation of the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Tangcal for the affected families within their jurisdiction.
