



# DSWD DROMIC Report on the Diarrhea Incident in Brgy. Sta. Ines, Tanay, Rizal

09 March 2024, 6AM

# I. Situation Overview

On 30 September 2022, residents of Sitios Kinabuan, Nayon, and Proper in Brgy. Sta. Ines, Tanay, Rizal experienced symptoms of diarrhea resulting in several casualties.

Diarrhoel disease or Diahrrea is defined as the passage of three or more loose or liquid stools per day (or more frequent passage than is normal for the individual). Frequent passing of formed stools is not diarrhea, nor is the passing of loose, "pasty" stools by breastfeed babies. Diarrhea is usually a symptom of an infection in the intestinal tract, which can be caused by a variety of bacterial, viral, and parasitic organisms. Infection is spread through contaminated food or drinking-water, or from person-to-person due to poor hygiene.
