

DSWD DROMIC Report on the Drowning Incident in Bulanao, Tabuk City, Kalinga

06 March 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 21 February 2024 at around 2:30 PM, a drowning incident was reported at Bulanao, Tabuk City, Kalinga, along the National Irrigation Canal and the Bulanao - CARAA Road. One victim, aged four (4) was found lifeless as a result of the drowning.
