
DSWD DROMIC Report on the Effects of Northeast Monsoon in Palawan

23 February 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

Issued on 25 January 2024 at 4:00 PM, partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated light rains brought by the Northeast Monsoon were observed to affect several parts of Luzon.

On the same day, several barangays in the municipalities of Aborlan and Taytay in Palawan reported that the strong winds and waves caused by the Northeast Monsoon had significant impact on the livelihood of the fisherfolks in the affected areas.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **3,714 families** or **18,392 persons** were affected in **13 barangays** in **Palawan** (see Annex A).

III. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱3,338,686.85** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱2,863,800.00** from **DSWD** and **₱474,886.85** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex B).
