I. Situation Overview

On 07 February 2024 at around 11:52 AM, a fire incident occurred at Block 40, Brgy. Addition Hills, Mandaluyong City. The fire was declared out at around 12:20 PM.

A total of 13 families or 58 persons were affected in Brgy. Addition Hills, Mandaluyong City (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **13 families** or **58 persons** sought temporary shelter at the **barangay hall** in **Brgy. Addition Hills, Mandaluyong City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of three (3) houses were totally damaged in Brgy. Addition Hills, Mandaluyong City (see Annex D).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P85,041.45** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex E).
