I. Situation Overview

On 18 February 2024 at around 12:30 PM, a fire incident occurred at Brgy. Fortuna, Marcos, Ilocos Norte.

One (1) family or four (4) persons are temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house is totally damaged in **Brgy. Fortuna, Marcos, Ilocos Norte** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱35,197.25** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱20,197.25** from **DSWD** and **₱15,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
