



DSWD DROMIC Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Hulo, Mandaluyong City

12 March 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 17 January 2024 at around 1:04 PM, a fire incident occurred at F. Blumentritt St., Brgy. Hulo, Mandaluyong City. The fire was declared out at around 1:47 PM.

A total of **27 families** or **79 persons** were affected in **Brgy. Hulo, Mandaluyong City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **27 families** or **79 persons** sought temporary shelter at **Saniboy Covered Court** in **Brgy. Hulo, Mandaluyong City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **nine (9) houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Hulo, Mandaluyong City** (see Annex D).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱176,624.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex E).
