

DSWD DROMIC Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Mansilingan, Bacolod City

18 March 2023, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 13 January 2024 at around 1:41 PM, a fire broke out in Brgy. Mansilingan, Bacolod City due to a faulty electrical wiring and was declared extinguished on the same day.

In response, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region VI, together with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Bacolod City, provided relief augmentation to support the immediate needs of the affected families and individuals.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **20 families** or **83 persons** were affected in **Barangay Mansilingan, Bacolod City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **20 families** or **83 persons** sought temporary shelter in **Barangay Mansilingan Gymnasium** in **Bacolod City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **five (5) houses** were damaged; of which, **three (3)** are **totally damaged** and **two (2)** are **partially damaged** in **Barangay Mansilingan, Bacolod City** (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱268,715.60** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families composed of **₱168,715.60** from the **DSWD** and **₱100,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex F).
