

## **DSWD DROMIC Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. San Isidro, San Juan, Ilocos Sur**

### **I. Situation Overview**

On 29 February 2024 at around 3:14 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. San Isidro, San Juan, Ilocos Sur.

A total of **six (6) families** or **16 persons** were affected in **Brgy. San Isidro, San Juan, Ilocos Sur** (see Annex A).

### **III. Status of Displaced Population**

#### **Outside Evacuation Center**

There are **six (6) families** or **16 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

### **IV. Damaged Houses**

A total of **two (2) houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. San Isidro, San Juan, Ilocos Sur** (see Annex C).

### **V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided**

A total of **₱177,376.88** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱80,276.88** from **DSWD** and **₱97,100.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
