I. Situation Overview

On **18 February 2024** at around **7:43 AM**, a fire incident occurred at **Brgy. Tulatula, Sibalom, Antique**.

Relative to the incident, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region VI provided relief augmentation to support the immediate needs of the affected family.
