I. Situation Overview

On 19 February 2024 at around 8 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Villamonte, Bacolod City, Negros Occidental.

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱14,226.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱8,426.00** from **DSWD** and **₱5,800.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
