

DSWD DROMIC Report on the Strong Wind Incident in Brgy. Bolalacao, New Lucena, Iloilo

16 February 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 11 September 2023 at around 2:30 PM, a house in Brgy. Bolalacao, New Lucena, Iloilo was struck by a fallen tree that was uprooted due to a strong wind incident brought by a localized thunderstorm.
