I. Situation Overview

On 11 March 2024 at around 10:00 AM, a strong wind incident occurred in Brgy. Granada, Bacolod City, Negros Occidental due to easterlies/localized thunderstorms. Source: DSWD Field Office (FO) VI

One (1) family or five (5) persons were affected in Brgy. Granada, Bacolod City, Negros Occidental (see Annex A).

III. Damaged Houses

One (1) house is partially damaged in in Brgy. Granada, Bacolod City, Negros Occidental (see Annex B).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱11,218.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱6,928.00** from **DSWD** and **₱4,290.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex C).
