



# DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. Campagao, Bilar, Bohol

30 January 2025, 6PM

## I. Situation Overview

On 23 February 2024 at around 6:50 AM, an armed conflict transpired in Brgy. Campagao, Bilar, Bohol between the troops of the Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP) and alleged members of the Communist Terrorists Group (CTG) that resulted in the displacement of families and individuals in the area.

# II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **250 families** or **770 persons** were affected in **Brgy. Campagao, Bilar, Bohol** (see Annex A).

## III. Status of Displaced Population

- a. Inside Evacuation Center
   A total of eight (8) families or 44 persons sought temporary shelter at the Brgy.
   Campagao Covered Court in Bilar, Bohol (see Annex B).
- b. Outside Evacuation Center A total of 242 families or 726 persons temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).
- c. Total Displaced Population
   A total of 250 families or 770 persons were displaced in in Brgy. Campagao,
   Bilar, Bohol (see Annex D).

# **IV.** Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱248,000.00 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families composed of ₱103,000.00 from DSWD and ₱145,000.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex F).
