

# DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Effects of Shear Line and Tropical Storm “Kabayan”

28 November 2024, 6AM

## I. Situation Overview

Last December 2023, the Philippines experienced significant meteorological events, attributed between the interaction of Shear Line and Tropical Storm Kabayan with the following key development and effects:

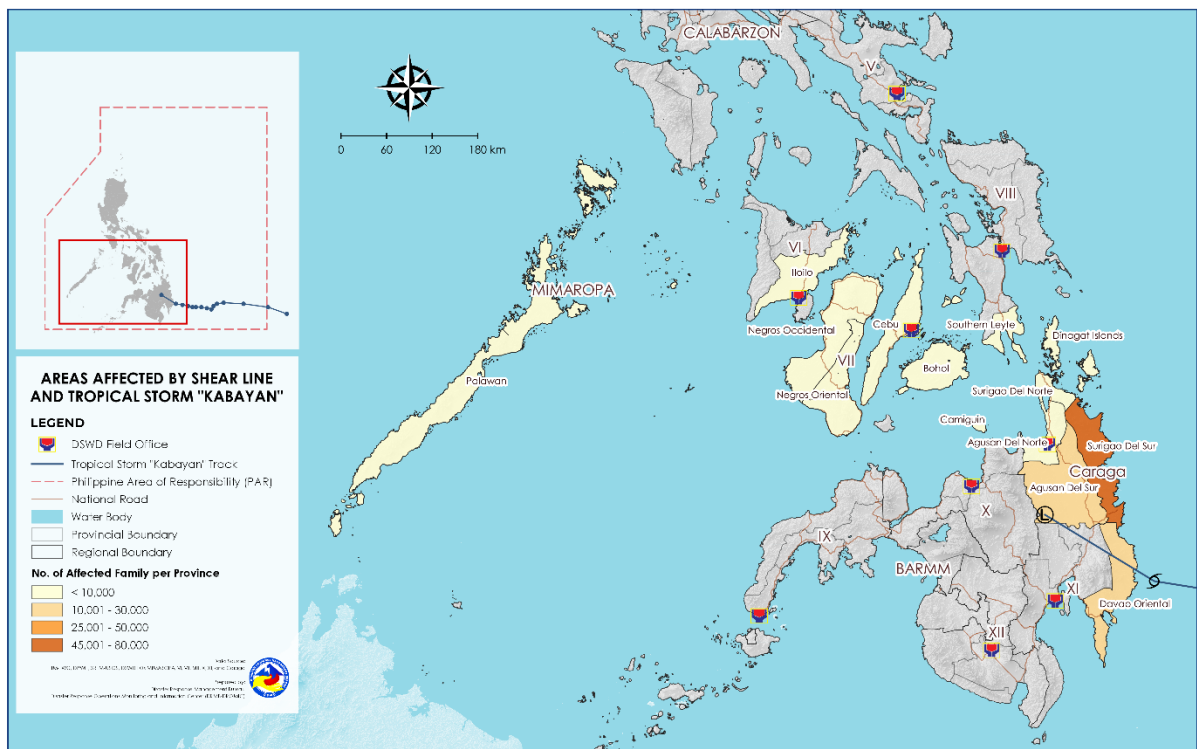
Gradually, on December 17, 2023, a Low-Pressure Area (LPA) east of Surigao del Sur has evolved into Tropical Depression locally named as "Kabayan." By 11 PM on the same day, "Kabayan" intensified into a Tropical Storm.

On December 18, 2023, "Kabayan" weakened into a Tropical Depression and made landfall over Manay, Davao Oriental. Subsequently, by 2:30 PM, "Kabayan" further weakened into an LPA, and at 5 PM, it diminished into a Remnant Low.

On December 20, 2023, the LPA (formerly "Kabayan") located west of Puerto Princesa, Palawan, continued moving away. Exiting the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR) on December 21, 2023.

Relative with the passage of "Kabayan," the Shear Line brought substantial rainfall to various parts of the country and resulted in significant effects on local weather conditions and varied impacts across different regions.

## II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **120,126 families** or **440,221 persons** are affected in **514 barangays** in **Regions MIMAROPA, VI, VII, VIII, X, XI, and Caraga** (see Annex A).

## III. Status of Displaced Population

### a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **45,660 families** or **152,789 persons** sought temporary shelter in **731 evacuation centers** in **Regions MIMAROPA, VI, VII, VIII, X, XI, and Caraga** (see Annex B).

### b. Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **21,322 families** or **77,388 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

### c. Total Displaced Population

A total of **66,982 families** or **230,177 persons** were displaced in **Regions MIMAROPA, VI, VII, VIII, X, XI, and Caraga** (see Annex D).

## IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **3,197 houses** were damaged; of which, **224** are **totally damaged** and **2,973** are **partially damaged** in **Regions MIMAROPA, VI, X, XI, and Caraga** (see Annex E).

## V. Cost of DSWD Assistance Provided

A total of **₱30,038,562.38** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱25,777,458.58** from **DSWD** and **₱4,126,445.80** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)**, **₱69,258.00** from **Non-Government Organizations (NGOs)**, and **₱65,400.00** from **other Partners** (see Annex F).
