

# DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Damayang Lagi, Quezon City

1 June 2024, 6AM

## I. Situation Overview

On 25 March 2024 at around 4:55 PM, a fire incident occurred at 13<sup>th</sup> St. Isla Noah, Brgy. Damayang Lagi, Quezon City. The fire was declared out at around 6:12 PM.

A total of **105 families** or **359 persons** were affected in **Brgy. Damayang Lagi, Quezon City** (see Annex A).

## III. Status of Displaced Population

### Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **105 families** or **359 persons** sought temporary shelter in **Scalabrini Theological House of Studies and Missionary Society of St., Paul** in **Brgy. Damayang Lagi, Quezon** (see Annex B).

## IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **37 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Damayang Lagi, Quezon** (see Annex C).

## V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱778,585.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱68,585.00** from **DSWD** and **₱710,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
