

DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Poblacion VII, Roxas City, Capiz

18 May 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 27 February 2024 at around 2:00 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Poblacion VII, Roxas City, Capiz. The fire was declared out at around 2:47 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **103 families** or **391 persons** were affected in **Brgy. Poblacion VII, Roxas City, Capiz** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **70 families** or **271 persons** sought temporary shelter in **two (2) evacuation centers** in **Brgy. Poblacion VII, Roxas City, Capiz** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **30 families** or **105 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

A total of **100 families** or **376 persons** were affected in **Brgy. Poblacion VII, Roxas City, Capiz** (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **87 houses** were damaged; of which, **83** are **totally damaged** and **four (4)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Poblacion VII, Roxas City, Capiz** (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱8,053,971.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱5,309,664.00** from **DSWD**, **₱1,035,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** and **₱1,709,307.00** from **other partners** (see Annex F).
