





DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. San Juan, Surigao City, Surigao del Norte

as of 13 April 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 12 March 2024 at around 03:50P PM, a fire incident occurred at Purok 3 Saint Arnold, Brgy. San Juan, Surigao City, Surigao del Norte. The fire was declared out at around 05:45 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **46 families** or **201 persons** were affected in **Brgy. San Juan, Surigao City, Surigao del Norte** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **45 families** or **192 persons** sought temporary shelter in **Surigao City National High School** in **Brgy. San Juan, Surigao City, Surigao del Norte** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or nine (9) persons temporarily stayed with their relatives (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

A total of **46 families** or **201 persons** were displaced in **Brgy. San Juan, Surigao City, Surigao del Norte** (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **40 houses** were damaged; of which, **37** are **totally damaged** and **three (3)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. San Juan, Surigao City, Surigao del Norte** (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}669,220.94\$ worth of assistance was provided to the affected families composed of \$\mathbb{P}522,140.94\$ from the DSWD and \$\mathbb{P}147,080.00\$ from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex F).
