





DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Flooding Incidents in Davao Occidental

06 October 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

Issued on 29 February 2024 at around 04:00 PM, cloudy skies with scattered rain showers and thunderstorms caused by Easterlies may have brought possible flash floods or landslides due to moderate to at times heavy rains in Caraga and Davao Region.

On the same day, several barangays in the municipalities of Malita and Sta. Maria in Davao Occidental experienced flooding due to Easterlies that resulted to displacement of families and individuals in the community.

Relative to the incident, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region XI, actively engaged in the monitoring of response operation, and coordinates with the concerned LGU for any significant updates and possible requests for relief augmentation.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **3,485 families** or **11,719 persons** are affected in **23 barangays** in **Davao Occidental** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **513 families** or **1,711 persons** sought temporary shelter in **three (3) evacuation centers** in **Davao Occidental** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **nine (9) families** or **28 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are **522 families** or **1,739 persons** displaced in **Davao Occidental** (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **18 houses** were damaged; of which, **17** are **totally damaged** and **one (1)** is **partially damaged** in **Davao Occidental** (see Annex E).
