



DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Kahupian, Sogod, Southern Leyte

as of 22 March 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 04 March 2024 at around 6:00 PM, a fire incident occurred at Brgy. Kahupian, Sogod, Southern Leyte.

In response, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region VIII, together with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Sogod, Southern Leyte, provided relief and financial assistance to support the immediate needs of the affected family.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

One (1) family or six (6) persons are affected in Brgy. Kahupian, Sogod, Southern Leyte (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or **six (6) persons** temporarily staying with their relatives. (see Annex C).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱19,118.40 worth of assistance was provided to the affected family composed of ₱9,188.40 from the DSWD and ₱10,000.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex F).
