





# DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. Bentangan, Carmen, North Cotabato

as of 24 April 2024, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 22 April 2024 at around 3:00 AM, an armed conflict transpired between warring armed groups in Sitio Gawasan, Brgy. Bentangan, Carmen, North Cotabato resulting in the displacement of families and individuals in the area.

## II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **523 families** or **2,615 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Bentangan, Carmen, North Cotabato** (see Annex A).

## III. Status of Displaced Population

#### **Inside Evacuation Center**

There are 523 families or 2,615 persons currently taking temporary shelter in eight (8) evacuation centers in Brgy. Bentangan, Carmen, North Cotabato (see Annex B).

## 2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 310,777 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 160,654 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 150,123 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 107,745 FFPs available at DSWD FO XII.
- ₱375.14 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO XII warehouses.
